SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE:

Selwyn Lowe joined Paskin Kyriakides Sands in 1997, was made an Associate the following year and became a Partner in 2007. He studied at Trinity Hall, Cambridge from 1975 to 1981 and has worked in Manchester, in Cambridge and in London since 1983.

Selwyn has extensive experience on a wide range of projects from inception and feasibility studies through to completion. His main areas of work include residential developments, houses for private clients, historic building work and retail development.

Projects include:

- **Highacres, Hyver Hill NW7** – development of a new high specification 8600 sq ft house in Mill Hill for a private client
- **3 Belsize Place NW3** – development of a very individual 8300 sq ft house in Belsize Park
